How to pronounce: HEL-SINK-EE

Economy: Helsinki's innovative economy focuses on technology, design, digital solutions, and maritime industries, serving as Finland's business and financial centre.

Good to know: Visit the serene Seurasaari Open-Air Museum island to experience traditional Finnish wooden architecture and culture in a beautiful forest setting away from city crowds.

Surrounding area: Helsinki is built on a peninsula surrounded by numerous islands and bays, featuring a relatively flat landscape with rocky outcrops, extensive shorelines, and green spaces throughout the city.

Best time to visit: Summer for long daylight hours and events like Flow Festival and Helsinki Festival; or winter for Christmas markets and the magical Lux Helsinki light festival, while spring brings the Helsinki Restaurant Day and autumn offers beautiful fall colours with fewer tourists.
