

### **Key facts**

- Price includes: International flights, taxes, all transfers and transportation as described, accommodation on a Bed & Breakfast board basis - excursions and entrance fees unless otherwise stated, and local, English-speaking guides.
- What to bring: Lightweight dry fast clothes, comfortable sandals, swimwear, mosquito repellent, hiking boots, a poncho or a rain jacket, and a crossbody bag.
- Language: Spanish, but you'll find many locals speak English, too.
- Entry requirements: British citizens don't need a visa to enter Costa Rica, but they must have a passport that's valid for a minimum of six months.
- Food and drink: Typical staple cuisine includes beans and rice, or fried plantains. Rondón is a well-known seafood and coconut stew, or you can try Chorreadas – a type of corn pancake. Wash these down with a bottle of Imperial – a favourite Costa Rican beer brand.
- Currency: The colón, although the US dollar's also widely accepted. That said, you might want to bring a small amount of local currency for drinks, tips and souvenirs.
- Shopping: There's plenty of free time in Tamarindo for shopping.
- Please note: Just so you know, the quality standards in some of Costa Rica's hotels may be lower than you'd expect in other destinations.
- Hotels: The hotels mentioned are subject to change, due to limited availability in some of the smaller hotels, you may be accommodated in a different hotel of a similar standard.

#### **Travelling distance: 219km**







Day 6

**Travelling distance: 22km** 

Upon arrival, get ready for a new adventure: visit the Arenal Volcano, the major attraction in La Fortuna region. Enjoy the most extraordinary view of the Arenal Volcano on a hike along the base and flanks of this giant. During the hike, the expert guide will explain to you all about the volcano: its activity periods, a little bit of history related to it and will show you some landmarks that have been left over the years. Astonishing views, ear-catching information, unbelievable stories and the chance to meet the local wildlife, will remain as your favorite memories of Costa Rica after this experience. Later this day, be part of a magical experience visiting the hanging bridges. This is a great combination of suspension bridges and platforms built in the forest that offers you an opportunity to explore the forest canopy in a safe and easy manner. Along the way, the density of biodiversity makes the trails a special place to admire the species of flora and fauna that you fin

Day 7

**Travelling distance: 92km** 

At the agreed time, check out and transfer to your next destination: Bijagua, a small town between volcanoes (Miravalles and Tenorio) that is also home to the majestic Rio Celeste. The virgin jungle of this region is home to tropical species of animals such as pumas, tapirs, sloth bears, anteaters, giant butterflies, and rare plant species. For birdwatching lovers this place is paradise. Upon arrival to Bijagua, visit Tapir Valley Nature Reserve, one of the easiest places to see the endangered Baird's Tapir in their wild habitat. The reserve boasts of lush green forests, wetlands, and a diverse range of flora and fauna. If you're a nature lover seeking an adventure, then this is the perfect destination for you. The reserve offers an unparalleled experience with its well-maintained trails and abundant wildlife.

Day 8

**Travelling distance: 10km** 

Today, you will discover Rio Celeste, considered one of Costa Rica's best kept secrets, as well as one of the best places for hikers. Along the trail, you can walk alongside the incredible Rio Celeste, admiring the abundant flora and fauna. Rio Celeste has a striking blue hue due to the sulphur emitted by the park's volcanic activity. While there are a variety of legends and myths in Costa Rica, this river is no exception. Legend has it that the gods, while colouring the skies, dipped their paintbrushes in the waters of this



### Day 12

#### **Travelling distance: 234km**

Breakfast included at the hotel. Afterwards, check out and get ready to discover your next beach destination: Punta Leona. You will stay in a hotel surrounded by tropical rainforest and beautiful beaches with shades of white sand washed by the emerald-green water of the Pacific Ocean. You will have plenty of time to enjoy the beach, swim in the crystal ocean water or just relax at the swimming pool. One of the highlights of your stay is the direct access to Playa Blanca, a crystal-clear water beach, calm waves and huge beauty that is in the Punta Leona. Before arriving to the Hotel, visit Carara National Park, which in indigenous Huetar language means "River of lizards", has the only transition forest in Central Pacific, resulting in diversity of flora and fauna, where converge typical species of dry and humid forests. This National Park is a worldwide known birding destination as it has very diverse birdlife, where Scarlet Macaw stands out. It is the first national park to have a universal access trail, where the visitors can experience the pristine forest.

### **Day 13**

### **Travelling distance: 85km**

Breakfast included at the hotel & check Out. A last adventure awaits before leave Costa Rica! Take a boat ride to visit the Guacalillo Estuary and the Tarcoles River, to observe one of the largest colonies of crocodiles in the world, the richest mangrove forest in biodiversity of the coast and the conservation area for the Scarlet Macaw, one of the most important in the country. The boat moves along the mangrove, with an impressive ecosystem composed of four mangrove species, they represent an important nesting area for mating and shelter of mammals and reptiles. Once the tour is finished, it's time to take the transfer to the Juan Santamaria International Airport to take your flight back home
