Key facts

- What to bring: Comfortable and light clothing, suncream and sunglasses.
- Language: Indonesian and Balinese.
- Entry requirements: For the most up-to-date passport and visa information, visit www.gov.uk/foreign-travel-advice.
- Food and drink: Try out the country's national dish - Nasi goreng. Or give satay or sate as it's called in Indonesia a try, which is meat on a skewer served with a sauce. There are vegetarian dishes too, such as Nasi timbel – rice wrapped in banana leaf.
- Currency: IDR – Indonesian rupiah. You might want to bring a small amount of local currency for drinks, meals, tips and souvenirs.
- Shopping: There'll be the opportunity to pick up bits and bobs from souvenir shops along the route.
- From the 14th February 2024, the Government of Bali Province will implement an International Tourist Levy of 150.000 IDR Indonesian Rupiah per person (incl. children) per stay (around £8 GBP). Payment can be done online by accessing Register Love Bali (<https://lovebali.baliprov.go.id/register>) before arrival. Once the payment is made, Love Bali will send paid notification as proof that guests has paid online. If you do not pay online before arrival, you can go to the bank counter at Ngurah Rai airport and pay via debit or credit card.
- We recommend you pay the tourist tax before arriving to Bali to fasten the process upon arrival and avoid delays.

Day 2

Travelling distance: km



Start the day with breakfast at your hotel, then head to the former Royal Spring Pools of Tirtha Gangga, which are now public pools. Travel up a narrow road, high above the sea to view Mount Seraya, the barren landscape is an amazing contrast to the deep blue sea and on a clear day you can see the island of Lombok. Lunch will be enjoyed at a small restaurant with a spectacular view. You will continue up the mountain to Pura Kehen Temple, one of the most beautiful on the island and then continue further east to the mighty volcano Gunung Agung.

Day 3

Travelling distance: km

After breakfast, travel by VW Kubel Wagen to Yeh Pulu Temple, a unique temple with a 25-meter carved wall which tells the story of Balinese people from the past. Next you will travel to Elephant Cave, a significant Hindu archaeological site and then enjoy lunch in a local restaurant. On the return journey you will see beautiful rice terraces at Tegallalang, before heading to Gunung Kawi Temple. The temple offers beautiful views and dates to the 11th century. Lastly travel to the rarely visited ancient relic of Goa Garba Temple, situated on a steep cliff off the banks of the river Pakersian.

Day 4

Travelling distance: km



Enjoy breakfast at the hotel and spend the rest of the morning strolling in Ubud. Known as the cultural heart of Bali, you can visit art museums and galleries or try out your bargaining skills at a traditional market in the middle of town. Transfer to your next hotel this afternoon and spend the rest of the day at leisure.

Day 5

Travelling distance: km

After breakfast, your first stop of the day is Bedugul, a pleasant mountain village on Lake Bratan where you will visit the botanical gardens and fresh market. Afterwards continue to the northern area of Bali and Munduk, passing through beautiful twin lakes Buyan and Tamblingan. Stop for lunch at a local restaurant, before exploring Munduk. A short trek through the rainforest to join a traditional wooden boat crossing across the lake.
