Key facts

- What to bring: Comfortable and light clothing, swimwear, walking boots or trainers, suncream, sunglasses and mosquito repellent. You'll need to dress respectfully when you visit any temple in Thailand – make sure your shoulders are covered, plus it's best to wear at least knee-length shorts or a skirt.
- Domestic flights: 20kg luggage allowance.
- Language: Thai, but most locals will speak English, too.
- Entry requirements: British citizens don't need a visa to enter Thailand, when staying for less than 30 days. You must have a passport that's valid for a minimum of six months.
- Food and drink: Thai food's world-famous, though, so you're going to want to try Pad Thai or a curry – the former's a stir-fried rice noodle dish. You can wash it down with a Chang beer.
- Currency: Baht, but the US dollar's widely accepted. You might want to bring a small amount of local currency for drinks, meals, tips and souvenirs.
- Shopping: Thailand's renowned for its markets, whether you want to buy souvenirs or street food. You may wish to visit the Phuket Town Central Market during your free time.

Day 1

Travelling distance: km

Welcome to Thailand! On arrival at Phuket airport, you will be greeted by your tour leader and assisted to join the transfer to Khao Sok National Park. In the afternoon you can relax at the hotel or go canoeing at the Sok river (subject to water level).

Day 2

Travelling distance: km



After breakfast, depart for your day trip to Cheow Lan Lake, an enormous man-made lake with limestone cliffs, crystal clear water and stunning views. The day includes a boat trip to experience the breathtaking views, a short hike with bamboo rafting to reach the Coral cave and lunch in a local restaurant. Return to the hotel in the afternoon to relax

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Day 3

Travelling distance: km

Start your day with breakfast before travelling to Phang Nga, where you will board a motorised long tail boat for a trip through the mangroves into the bay. Phang Nga is known for its islands, with the most famous being James Bond Island, which was featured in The Man with the Golden Gun film. Lunch is included at the Muslim fishing village Panyee Island, followed by an island tour. This unique village is completely built on stilts, you will see the houses, shops, the school and a floating football field. In the late afternoon you will arrive at your hotel in Krabi.

Day 4

Travelling distance: km



After breakfast you will visit the sacred Buddhist temple Wat Thum Sua or The Tiger Cave Temple, known for the tiger paw prints in the cave and the strenuous flight of stairs to reach the entrance. You will continue to visit Tha Pom Klong Song Nam canal, known as the two-coloured canal, because it changes from cloudy blue when the sea rises, to a beautiful clear turquoise colour when the sea water recedes. There is also a 700m long wooden bridge with evergreen forest swamp on both sides and in some spots, it is possible to swim, canoe or paddle in the canals.

Day 5

Travelling distance: km

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel and then enjoy a day at leisure in Krabi. You could enjoy the beach and facilities at the hotel or join an optional excursion provided by the tour leader on site.

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Day 6

Travelling distance: km

After breakfast depart for Phuket, also known as the 'Pearl of the Andaman Sea'. In Phuket you will visit a pearl farm, with a brief stop at the factory and showroom. Arrive at your hotel in Phuket and enjoy the rest of the day at leisure.
