- Currency: Vietnamese dong. You might want to bring a small amount of local currency for drinks, meals, tips and souvenirs.
- Shopping: There'll be the opportunity to pick up bits and bobs from souvenir shops along the route.

Board your boat at around 4:30pm for your sunset adventure with a twist. Before we sit back and enjoy the sun setting over the scenery of the Mekong riverbank we'll head to the local market, where we'll try our hand at bartering to pick up some local snacks for our cruise.

Afterwards we'll reap our rewards with a delicious cold beer or soft drink as the sun sets across the mighty Mekong River. After the boat ride, enjoy the rest of the day at leisure.



After breakfast, embark on a boat ride in one of Can Tho's floating markets. Today's journey starts bright and early as you'll be joining the locals at Cai Rang, one of Can Tho's bustling floating markets. Your journey will be quite different from your usual daily commute as you'll make your way by boat as the sun rises. The market sells an assortment of local produce from vegetables to fruit but this morning we'll try our negotiation skills and then we sample a bowl of the local Hu Tieu noodles, a typical breakfast for the Mekong neighbourhood.

Your guide will meet you at your hotel and transfer you to the airport for your flight to Danang. Upon arrival, your guide will be waiting to transfer you to your hotel in Hoi An and be welcomed with a refreshing cocktail. Enjoy the rest of the day at leisure.

After breakfast, enjoy a full-day city tour of Hoi An.
Vietnamese lunch, followed by Hoi An boat ride. Enjoy a
full-day tour of Hoi An with your local guide. Learn about
this former port town and the influence of many
international cultures on the aesthetics of this UNESCO
town. Begin with a visit to the 17th century Chua Ong
Pagoda before visiting the Jinshang Temple at the Phuc Kien
Assembly Hall. Take a short walk to Tam Ky House, a 200
year old ancestral house before visiting Hoi An's most
recognizable sight - the Japanese Covered Bridge which
dates back to the 17th century. After enjoying a delicious
Vietnamese lunch, take a short boat trip down the river to
visit local artisans making ceramics at a craft village. End
your tour with a visit to the docks where you will see the
traditional fishing boats and iconic bamboo basket boats.



#### Travelling distance: km

After breakfast, transfer to Tra Que village (lunch included). Continue to Tam Thanh village, following your visit to Tam Tanh village you will journey onto Ky Anh Tunnel. After exploring the village and tunnels you will head back via the Heroic Mother Thu statue. She stands 18.6m high and 120m wide, and was designed to resemble Mrs. Nguyen Thi Thu, who sadly lost 12 children and grandchildren during the Vietnam War.


